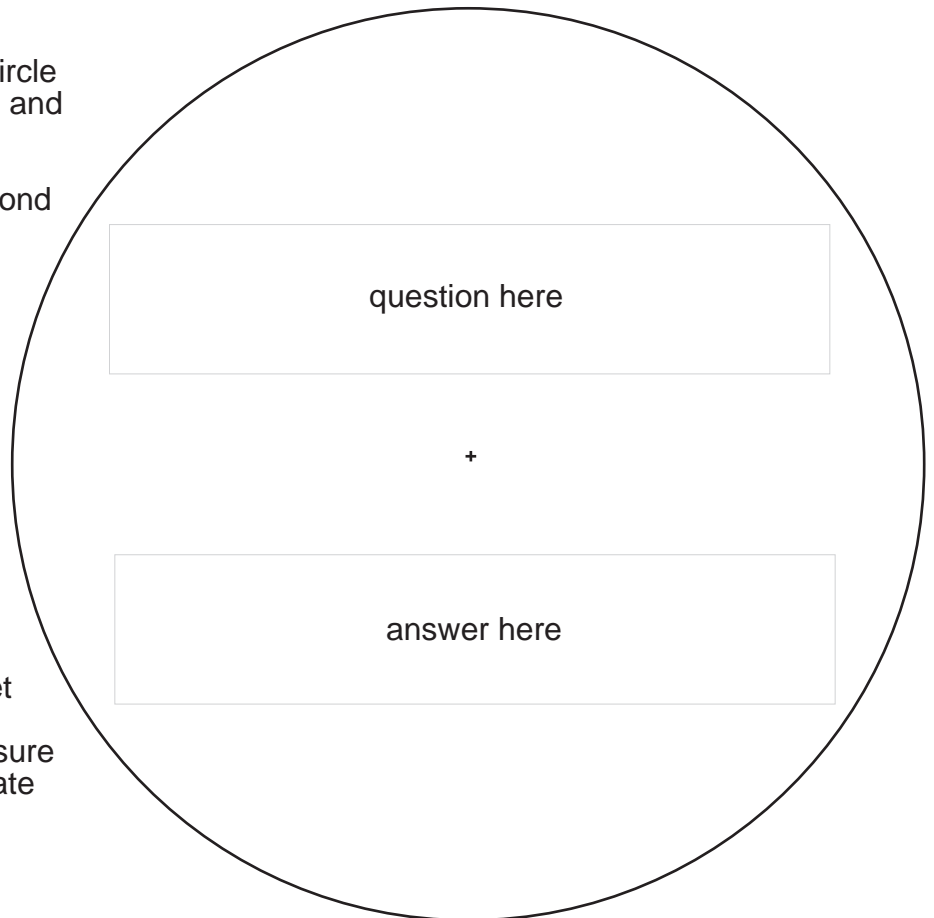


Top Paper Plate Pattern

1. Cut out circle.
2. Cut out area for window.
(This is your template for cutting out the window on your paper plate.)
3. So the template doesn't slide around, temporarily secure it to paper plate using tape at edges.
4. Cut out window from the paper plate.
5. Punch hole in center (+) of paper plate.
6. Remove pattern and save.

Bottom Paper Plate Pattern

1. On the next page you will find a circle with boxes to type your questions and answers. Print your page.
2. Cut out only the circle.
3. Permanently paste circle to a second paper plate.
4. Punch hole in center (+) of plate.



Constructing Your Plate

1. Line up holes.
2. Place rivet into both holes from front.
3. Turn both plates over.
4. Place washer over rivet.
5. Place tool that came with rivet set over the rivet.
6. Tap lightly with a hammer being sure to leave enough space for top plate to rotate.
