

Highlighted Changes to the FNP PAS-FY 2008

Changes this year are minimal but you will notice them as you deliver evaluations and enter programming activity into the online Program Activity Sheet. The User's Guide has been updated as has the Data Collection Form available on the FNP website.

- 1) Logging into the reporting site has changed-you will now have to put ad\ (not case sensitive) before your user name. This is an additional security measure for the entire INTRANET.
- 2) Primary Curriculum-one curriculum has been deleted HELP-two have been added-Loving your Family-Feeding their Future and Teen Parents Nutrition for Pregnant Teens
- 3) Parental Handouts Questions-has been added in the Primary Curriculum box-Did you send home a Parental Handout? Simple answer Yes or No
- 4) Primary Programming Message-Food Safety is added back in as an option
- 5) Two new Adult Evaluation questions have been added-one for Fiber and one for Fluid intake. These were created to accompany the displays for Fiber and Whole Grain but also to fill the void for the Thirsty Display. All other displays were reviewed and those without accompanying evaluation tools have been updated so that one is available for printing directly from the FNP website.]

General Information

Cut off date for FY 2007 is Oct 10th and the day to start inputting FY 2008 is Oct 15th

Be careful not to transcend two fiscal years with your 3-6 grade Pre and Post tests

Reminder-for those of you that wait until the last minute to enter your PAS's and survey data, DON'T wait too long-time gets away from you and this data is a required in order to accurately compile reports for USDA and SRS.

There has been an additional line added to your Program Data Collection Sheet (taken to programming sites to record data needed on the PAS) where you can record the number of evaluations that you have collected at that site. If you would attach that sheet to your surveys, data entry would be much more efficient and accurate.
